Welcome: What helps you most to engage with God?

Worship: Spend some time in worship. Plan an act of worship that is appropriate to your group.

Word: Looking at God's word together:

Read Ephesians 3:14-21 (NIV)

- 1. The word power is associated with God's enabling. It occurs 3 times in the passage. What ways does God enable us according to this passage?
- 2. Paul uses 4 different adjectives to describe Christ's love (v18). What do we understand about ...
 - The 'width' of Christ's love?
 - The 'length' of Christ's love?
 - The 'height' of Christ's love?
 - The 'depth' of Christ's love?
- 3. What does it mean to know that Christ's love 'surpasses knowledge' (v19)?
 - What does this mean to us personally, not just in our heads but in our hearts?
- 4. What does it look like to be filled 'to the measure of all the fulness of God.'?

- 5. Paul opens up the possibility that there is so much to knowing God than we have experienced (v20).
 - In what ways have we limited our expectations of what God can and cannot do in and through us?
 - How can we change this expectation?
- 6. How confident are we that God is able to do 'immeasurably' more in our lives?

Witness: What would our witness to others look like if we had a greater confidence in what God can do through us by His Holy Spirit?

Prayer:

- Is there anything in your own life for which you need prayer?
- Pray that you will have a greater confidence in exercising the gifts that God has given you.
- Pray with expectancy that God will do so much more in our own lives and through his church this coming year.
- Pray for the homes in the immediate vicinity of our own home.
- Pray for those on the mission field.
